O. Allen Alexander, of Hopkins formerly of Darlington died on Tuesday, November 8, 2016.

Allen was taken back to his hometown of Darlington to be buried on the family lot in Grove Hill Cemetery on Thursday, November 10, 2016.

Allen was born in Florence, South Carolina and was the son of the late Oscar Alexander and Odessa Snowden Alexander. He served his country in the United States Army, graduated from Clemson University and South Carolina University School of Law in 1973. Following graduation Allen practiced law in Darlington, Conway and Columbia. Allen was dedicated member of the Zeta Fraternity, as well as the Tree of Life Congregation in Columbia.

Surviving are his loving wife of 23 years, Cheri Donna Alexander of Hopkins; and by his son, David Alexander.
