Betty Lee Braddock Keith, 94, of Society Hill died on Saturday, December 11, 2021.

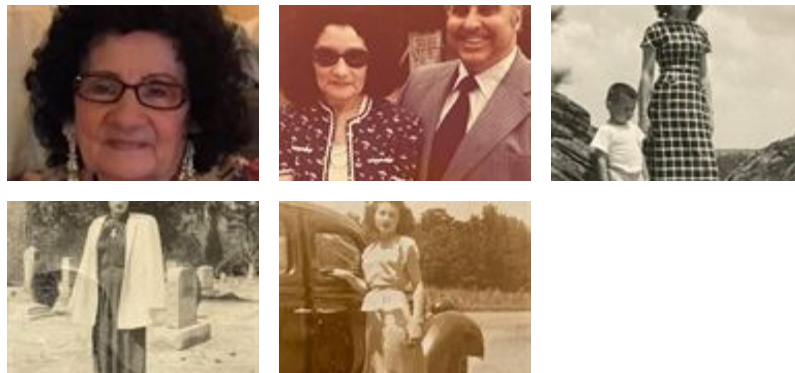
