Catherine D. Sandifer. 90, of Florence died June 18, 2018.

Funeral services will be held Saturday, June 23, 2018 at 3 PM in the Kistler-Hardee Funeral Home Chapel. Interment will follow at Tabernacle United Methodist Church Cemetery. The family will receive friends at the funeral home one hour prior to the service.

Miss Sandifer was born in Florence County and lived her entire life on the same farm she was born on. She was the daughter of the late Charles Hightower and Lena Irene Zehe Sandifer.

She was a charter member of the First Southern Methodist Church in Florence and active member of the Florence Southern Methodist Church until her death. she loved them all dearly. She was the family photographer, having captured and photographed every family event for two generations. She loved to do needlework and her creations were divided among her family. She remembered birthdays with a card and was quick to send a note thanking you for any act of kindness.

Catherine worked for many years at Aiken Loan and Security that later became Fleet Funding. After retirement she devoted the rest of her life to her church and her family.
