Edward C. Jones, of Darlington, SC died on Thursday, August 4, 2022.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, August 6, 2022, at 11 AM at Trinity United Methodist Church, 126 Pearl Street, Darlington, SC.

Ed was born in Faison, North Carolina, the son of Ennis C. and Christine Taylor Jones. He received a Bachelor's Degree from Pembroke State University, a Master's Degree in School Administration from Appalachian State University and a Doctorate in Education from Nova University. Ed was a member of several educational organizations and Trinity United Methodist Church in Darlington, SC. He served as Principal at Aynor High School for many years and retired after serving as Principal at St. John's High School in Darlington, SC. Ed enjoyed reading Civil War and World War II histories. He was an avid golfer and played for many years.
