“ I feel led to write this. It’s my hope most of you will understand the intent of it. Closure. Mike Ray and I joined the same church in 2017, in my case, and I assume his, to start out fresh on our paths to redemption in Him. I most definitely wasn’t the most grounded person in those days, but I was trying to be. The last time I saw Mike was in January of this year at Solicitor Burch’s investiture in Chesterfield. As a newly ordained pastor, fresh out of seminary, I’d been asked by the solicitor to offer the benediction at one of the most important days of his life. Mike was there, along with 200 plus others. Afterwards, Mike came up to me, and looked me square in the eye. Believe me, he could have gone anywhere else, talked to more important people, but he came to me, rather rapidly, I noticed, and said with firm conviction that he was extremely proud of me. Not another word. He would not let go of my hand that he’d extended for a handshake, for over 45 seconds. He said nothing else, smiled, and walked off to the reception, which I skipped. (I wanted to get home to my wife). From 2017 - 2019, I wrongly looked at Mike as a competitor in our church, and that messed me up, and most definitely messed up any chance for a good relationship and friendship with him, work with the then church pastor, and with most of that congregation, and most importantly, with God. The latter relationship, the one with God, has sense been corrected. I regret my actions that led me to be seen as an unworthy friend candidate to Mike, or to anyone else, in that time frame. I got big headed and felt entitled then. My failed friendship with him was definitely a marvelous teacher. The failure taught me more than most seminary classes did. It taught me HOW NOT TO BEHAVE in a church setting. Church life isn’t a competition. It’s my deepest regret to date that I never accepted a friendship Mike freely gave anyone, and at one time, wanted to give me. Any time I saw him after 2019, we both moved to other church pursuits by then, he always spoke, well up until the Burch event, which was usually at the post office. I am glad he was loved by so many, and I’m glad I had that moment with him in January because of Solicitor Burch. I don’t always get things right, definitely not back then, and I’m so sorry for my role in the dysfunction that kept me from being a friend to a man that helped so

many. Does any of this make sense? I sure hope it does, and I hope all who read this and feel the love it's intended to convey. I'm glad Mike was loved, and I'm glad we had the moment in January he alone made happen. He was always teaching. May he rest in peace, and may you all reading this, find peace in his death, and find love in my words here. But for the grace of God go I.
