Philip Ronald Sheldon, 84, of Darlington, SC, formerly of Shady Side, MD died Wednesday, December 28, 2022 peacefully at his home.

PHil was born in Leominster, MA on May 30, 1938, son of Harold and Blanche (Bissett) Sheldon. At 18 years of age Phil joined the US Coast Guard retiring as a Chief Warrant Officer after 20 years of service.
