Robert B. (Bob) Clayton, longtime resident of Quinby, quietly passed away on Christmas Day, 2018, surrounded by his family. He bravely fought dementia and was diagnosed with lung cancer and Parkinson disease in April, 2018. His parents were the late Philip J. Clayton and Mildred Hite Clayton of Lexington. Bob was born in Columbia, South Carolina on October 28, 1938. He grew up in Columbia and attended Schneider Elementary and Wardlaw Junior High. His family moved to West Columbia and he attended Brookland-Cayce High School.
