August 16, 1926 - November 11, 2023

Sadie was born in Florence, South Carolina on August 16, 1926, to Samuel Benjamin and Dessie Belle Weatherford. She spent her childhood living in Latta and the Temperance Hill community of Marion County. She later moved to Darlington where she was raised by her father and her loving stepmother, Isadora Drew Weatherford. She finished high school in Darlington and went on to attend Winthrop College. She married Franklin David Weaver, Sr November 22, 1946. She then became the stepmother to “Anne” Weaver Kemp and Franklin “Danny” Weaver.

She is survived by her son, Henry Grady Weaver, III and wife Fran, and her half-brother, Homer Weatherford. She is predeceased by Franklin, Anne, Danny, and half-brothers S.B. Weatherford, Jr., Don C. Weatherford, half-sisters Dorothy W Pruitt, Virginia W Isgett, her special niece Debbie Pruitt Cross, and grandson Cliff Kemp.
