Mrs. Rogers exemplified a life well lived. For almost a century she was a prominent member of the Darlington Community. Although her garden club days have long since passed, Central Drug Store and Quality Flower Shop closed many years ago, and entertaining her friends at her garden parties had come to an end, her real life's work will carry on through future generations.

Her children, Paula Bowen and husband, Bill, along and her son, Dr. Ted Rogers and Kim Littlefield, will carry the torch of her love for the Lord and her community, and in true, Ralph and Udelle Rogers form, they will pass it along to their grandson, William Bowen III and wife Lauren.
