



## William Jacob Odom IV (Jake)

William Jacob Odom IV (Jake), 86, passed away peacefully on January 8, 2024 at

age 2 until he was 15 and then moved back to Darlington to be with his mother. As a youth he was involved in Scouting, even becoming a Scout Leader for several years after he moved to NC. He graduated from Darlington High School in 1955 and enjoyed attending many Class Reunions throughout the years. He served in the Army National Guard of SC for three years from 1961-1963 obtaining an Honorable discharge at the end of his service.

Jake spent his career employed by and a manager of Winn-Dixie Grocery Stores for a total of 40 years starting in SC and then moved to NC spending most time in Kinston NC. After his retirement, he and Marian moved to Lake Santee Cooper where he enjoyed his retirement by keeping his two grandchildren during the summer and fishing and hosting many fish fries and Christmas family functions for everyone to enjoy.

Recently and due to diminishing health, Jake and Marian moved back to Lamar, SC to be closer to family.

Jake had a strong faith and was always involved in the local Methodist Church in whatever community he and his family were living. He was very involved in the Methodist Men group at Jordan United Methodist Church in Summerton, SC.
